Works to the church tower clock including:

The removal to the workshop and overhaul of the clock movement, weight pulleys, bevel gears and universal dial motion works connecting joint. Following testing, the return and refitting of the parts on site, with re-hanging of the weights on new galvanised steel cables, and synchronising of hands with the movement. Disconnecting and cleaning of the 2 x V-Crank connecting levers, re-assembling and rewiring them from the movement to the strike hammer with stainless steel wire.

Directions to petitioner
